General Description of Product: **Hot-melt Adhesive used for Packaging**

1. COMPLIANCE WITH EUROPEAN REGULATIONS

- a. The product is manufactured in compliance with the Commission Regulation (EC) No 2023/2006 on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come in to contact with food, considering all rules applicable to it.
- b. Compliance with Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 can be confirmed for the requirements of traceability and good manufacturing practice. The risk assessment of the adhesive regarding Article 3 of this Regulation was made by the received information in respect to the composition and compliance with the following provisions below.
- c. All components are in compliance with the Commission Regulation (EU) 10/2011 on plastic materials and articles intended to come in to contact with food.
 - i. Due to supplier information the following substances might occur, for which specific restrictions are defined in the Plastics Regulations (EU) No 10/2011:

Acetic acid vinyl ester : SML = 12mg/Kg
2,6-Di-tert-butyl-p-cresol (BHT), SML = 3mg/kg of food or food simulant
 - ii. "Dual used additives" as defined in Commission Regulation (EU) No 10/2011: BHT (E321) as additive in the raw materials



2. COMPLIANCE WITH NATIONAL LEGISLATION (EU member states)

- a. Some components are in compliance with Decree Nr. 2007-766 of May 10th 2007 and its modifications
- b. Some components are listed in BfR XXV – Hard Paraffins, Microcrystalline Waxes and Mixtures of these with Waxes, Resins and Plastics, valid for application for non-fatty food only. Other components are listed in BfR XXXV – Copolymers of Ethylene, Propylene, Butylene, Vinyl Esters and Unsaturated Aliphatic Acids, and their Salts and Esters

3. OTHER NATIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS (non EU member states)

All components are listed in FDA (Food drug administration) regulation, in 21CFR 175.105 (adhesives for use as components of articles in packaging, transport or holding food). This regulation specifies that the adhesive is either separated from food by a functional barrier, or used subject to the following additional limitations: (a) The amount of adhesive that contacts packaged dry foods shall not exceed the amounts of good manufacturing practice; (b) The quantity of adhesive that contacts packaged fatty and aqueous foods shall not exceed the trace amount at seams and at edge exposure between packaging laminates that may occur within the limits of good manufacturing practice, and under normal conditions of use the packaging seams or laminates will remain firmly bonded without visible separation

The food contact status is based on the compositional information provided by the raw material supplier and is given on the best of our knowledge. The technical suitability for the final application needs to be determined by the user under the intended conditions of use. This might cover extraction and/or migration tests and the evaluation of the possible influence on the organoleptic properties of the food.

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
